



GUIDELINES FOR IN-PERSON WORSHIP & ONLINE SERVICES

Dear Macedonia MB Church Family and Friends,

We are excited to be returning to in-person worship, but things will be a little different than usual.

While we cannot guarantee a germ-free environment, we are taking extraordinary steps to ensure all areas are clean and disinfected. Here's the current plan for our in-person worship at MMBC:

what's the plan?

>> Q: WHEN WILL IN-PERSON WORSHIP START?

Beginning April 4, 2021, we will be back to meeting in-person EVERY Sunday of the month, with social distancing guidelines in place.

>> Q: WHAT ARE SERVICE TIMES?

Service will be held from 10:00am - 11:00am. You can access the building starting at 9:15am

>> Q: DO I NEED TO REGISTER?

In order to plan our space and maintain capacity limits, it's important to know you will be coming. Please call the church office or [send us a message](#). We'd love for you to join us!

>> Q: WILL THERE BE YOUTH CHURCH AVAILABLE?

At this time we will not have Youth Church. However, the youth are welcomed to enjoy service in a designated room.

>> Q: WHAT IF I'M UNCOMFORTABLE RETURNING TO WORSHIP?

God is present as you worship in your home and God is present when you worship in the sanctuary. **DO NOT FEEL PRESSURED TO RETURN TO IN-PERSON WORSHIP IF THIS IS NOT THE BEST DECISION FOR YOU AND YOUR FAMILY!**

>> Q: WHAT ARE THE HEALTH & SAFETY PROTOCOLS?

Your well-being is our top priority! MMBC practices the most current health and social distancing measures for your safety and in consideration of all in attendance. Please review these guidelines below:

1. MASKS: For the benefit of every guest, we ask everyone to wear a mask at all times. If you do not have a mask or forget yours, we will have disposable masks available upon arrival.

2. HEALTH CHECKS: Please do not attend in-person if you are experiencing persistent coughing, fever or difficulty breathing. Please do not attend if you are in a high-risk group. Our online services will still be available for your convenience.

3. HUGS AND HANDSHAKES: We are a loving group and we enjoy hugs, handshakes and high fives, but for the comfort of others, we ask that you refrain and offer an "air hug" or an "air high five" instead.

4. CLEANING & SANITATION: Our team has thoroughly and diligently cleaned the building in preparation for your arrival! We will actively clean throughout the morning. Additionally, there are several hand sanitizing stations for your convenience.

>> Q: ANYTHING ELSE TO KNOW?

Here are a few logistics that may look a little different when you return!

- Restrooms will be open but monitored for crowds and lines.
- Sorry, water fountains will be disabled. We will have bottled water available!
- The sanctuary seating will be reserved for senior and elderly members. All others will be seated in classroom spaces with TV monitors. Ushers will direct you to maintain social distancing guidelines.
- Families are encouraged to sit together while maintaining 6 feet of distance between other groups.

Let's all do our part to keep OURSELVES and OTHERS safe and comfortable. We've missed you and can't wait to see you!
